When COVID-19 hit, SVdPLA received a sharp increase in calls for help. COVID-19 forced us to temporarily close our thrift stores and cancel in-person charitable work, so meeting the increased demand for assistance was challenging. Despite our strained resources, our team worked tirelessly while also abiding by the new health and safety precautions.

As a result, our stores did not lay off any employees. Our volunteers adjusted charity work to comply with CDC recommendations. Our Cardinal Manning Center continued to serve the unhoused, and our Vincentians even expanded their reach after partnering with the Archdiocese of Los Angeles. Because of our supporters, SVdPLA not only survived the worst of the pandemic, we continued providing lifesaving homelessness prevention and relief services, giving thousands hope in a time of crisis.

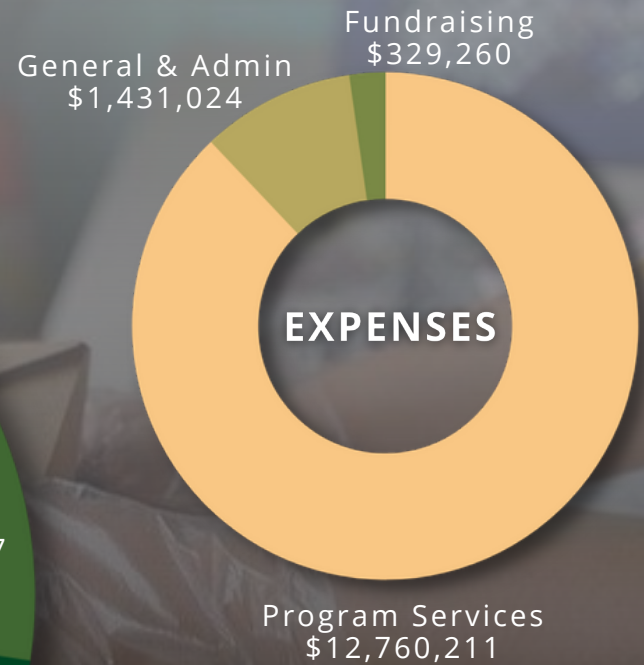
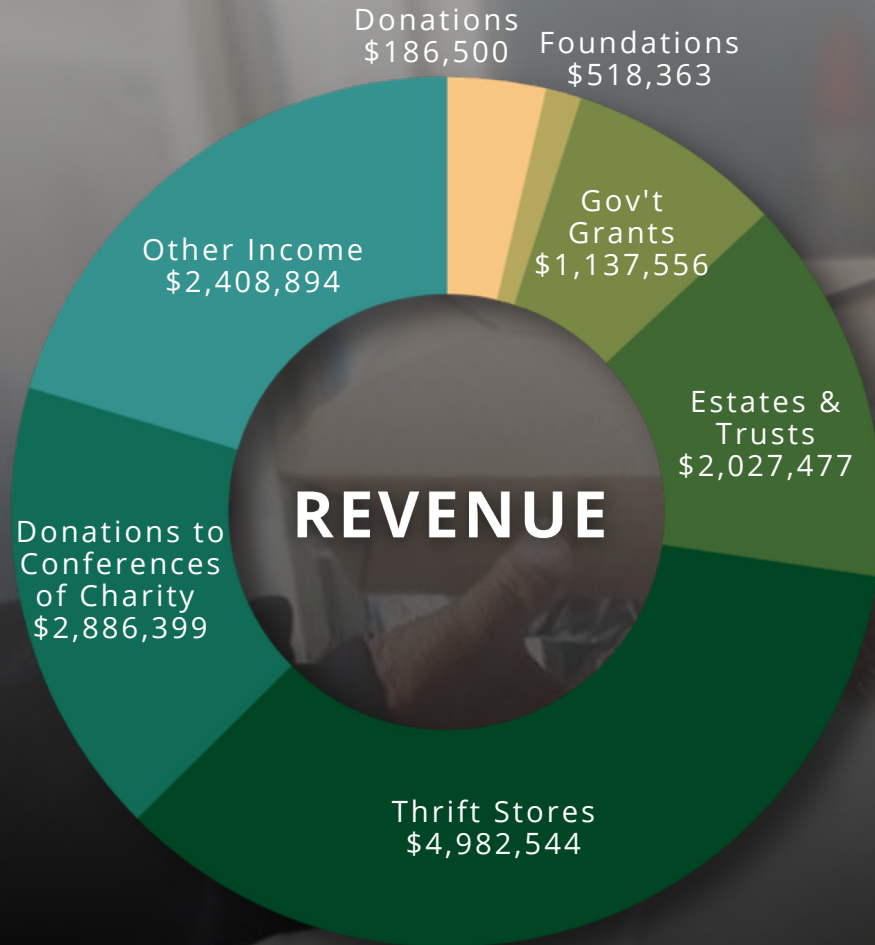


# CIRCLE V RANCH CAMP
