Services We Offer:

- House in a Box: New household essentials for help families rebuild after a disaster.
- Financial Assistance: Assistance with relocation, utilities, basic needs, and more.
- Assistance with Clothing, food, hygiene products, and miscellaneous supplies.
- Mental Health Support & Community Resources.

Process:

- To initiate assistance, individuals should meet one-on-one with a DRC. During this meeting, the DRC will assess their situation and discuss available forms of assistance through SVDPLA and community resources.

Eligibility Criteria:

- Direct impact by the disaster.
- Identification for heads of household.
- Supporting documentation as needed.

Processing Time:

- The time required to process financial assistance requests varies based on the specific support being provided for each case.

Funding Source:

- All funding is sourced from the LA Council, which guarantees timely and efficient assistance delivery. Additionally, long-term recovery grants from partners such as the American Red Cross contribute to strengthening local resilience.
